Last Sunday afternoon was simply a joy. It was a joy to paint the Kurna shield that was previously chalked and now fading. It was a joy to hear Mark Kickett, Congress Development and Outreach Officer, speak about the importance of land for our Indigenous brothers and sisters. It was a joy to

watch Lynda (Barkindgji) draw the outline of the new artwork signifying 'meeting together'. It was a joy to see children and adults painting together. It was an immense privilege and honour to be involved.

Three years ago the first ground art was created with Sean (Kurna & Ngarrindjeri) and Denise and Candice (Adnyamathanha). It featured in the Advertiser at the time and has the blessing of Kurna elders. Sean and other Indigenous leaders are delighted it has been painted.

The Kurna shield is a symbol of protection of this land and of God's protection of this place. The new artwork is symbolic of people meeting together with God as our centre - the symbol in the middle is the symbol for the Trinity. We meet together with God and with each other - and we continue to journey together.


