Lent has begun. Lent is a period of reflection, meditation and preparation for Easter. We set aside 40 days (representing the time that Jesus spent in the desert before the beginning of his public ministry) to act, reflect and connect in ways that model the life of Jesus. Connecting with the love of God, we ponder our relationship with God and the journey of Jesus towards the cross.

There are various ways to engage with Lent:

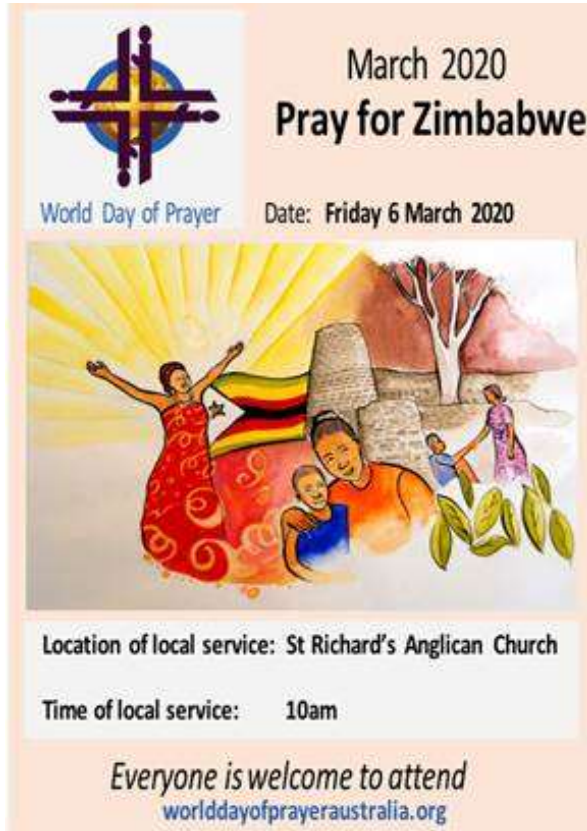
