We acknowledge that we meet on the traditional lands of the Kaurna people. We pay respect to their traditions and their elders and commit to working toward reconciliation in our land.

Today is Christ the King or Reign of Christ Sunday. The origin of Christ the King Sunday is relatively recent. It was named in 1925 by Pope Pius XI, and it entered into the Protestant Church only during the nineteen-sixties. Pope Pius XI designated this Sunday simply because the church needed to be reminded that Jesus Christ was the King.

On its first celebration, Mussolini had been the leader of Italy for three years; and Hitler had been out of jail for almost a year. Hitler's Nazi party was growing in popularity, and the world lay in a great Depression.

The lectionary gospel reading (Matthew 25.31-46) reminds us that the Kingdom of God is about how we live as much as it is about who we believe in.


